August 14th, 2018

Opening

The regular meeting of the Glendale Elementary - School Advisory Committee was called to order at 4:05 PM on 8/14/18 in room 514 by Principal Adam Faust.

Approval of Minutes

Meeting minutes from 5/08/18 were unanimously approved.

Chairman's Report

Ms. Poysell welcomed everyone to the meeting. She discussed Gator Express, Glow Party/Burgers and BINGO and Teacher/Staff Appreciation Week for the upcoming school year.

Principal's Report

- 1) The treasury has a balance of \$7,289.71. The budget increased in concert with the school improvement plan.
- 2) Wheeler moved to Title I Position to accommodate 4th & 5th grade students.
- 3) Discussion on Glendale Elementary School's latest report card with focuses on learning gains in the bottom quartile. Our goal is to improve core instruction in all content areas.

New Business

- 1) **Safety-** Mr. Faust reported that GES will be conducting a fire drill and a code red drill. He also issued a reminder to keep all doors locked and windows covered.
- 2) **SIP Update and EOY Review-** The Learning Alliance (LA) funds a 3rd Grade interventionist position this year. Ms. Sims works with small groups of our "bubble kids" to work on specific skills that they are finding challenging.
- 3) **SIP Planning for 2018-19-** we will soon be in the process of beginning the writing of our SIP for next year. We will be using the data collected this year to help us in planning and writing the SIP.
- 4) **Impact Information-** Our application to be a Deep Dive School with the LA has been accepted. This will provide us with three things; first a 3rd grade interventionist funded by the LA, second a K-2 Moonshot Coach (funded by the LA) who is going to work with eight teachers and their students to help boost achievement, third we are going to participate in the Moonshot Academy. This academy is funded by the LA and consists of three 6 week sessions that meet three times a week. These weeks can happen whenever the school wants them to.
- 5) **Parent Involvement:** SAC discussed ways to provide parents with volunteer opportunities within the school. Counsel discussed implementing new committees, clubs, Harvest Dance, and before & after school programs.
- 6) **Next Meeting:** scheduled for the second Tuesday of every month. We will review the Gator Express, school functions, and recruiting parents to join SAC.
